TLC Club Name: Before we could register the club with the Department of

Fair Trading also open a Club Bank Account we needed an Official Club Name.

Designing our Club Emblem: In the first few months the general meetings dealt with many items one being our Club Emblem. We had about 10 -15 designs prepared/submitted by members. However Clarrie Stevens and Roy Curnow had prepared a couple of great designs. Members finally decided on the current design of Clarrie and Roy. The colours were indicative of our red centre of Aussie surrounded by blue ocean.

Club Shirts: Early Newsletters record that Alice the Editor wrote "Well Des came home very excited after the November 2006

meeting regarding action about our club shirt. He said the meeting discussed many ideas and features of shirts until he was completely confused. That the members then moved that the Committee of Management should make the final decision. He said all he has to do at the next meeting is stand up show the selected shirt and say "this is it".

Colour of Club Shirt: The general meeting had looked at 15 – 20 shirts supplied by members. After exciting debate we finally selected our club colour as the NSW colour "Dark Blue and Light Blue".


Purchasing Shirts: The shirt had to be cotton. This proved a major problem as we could only purchase the range of size from small to 3XL in just six colours. The only one that covered all sizes and was acceptable to members was our current blue/yellow shirt. So in the end the choice was very simple.

Current Shirt: Members then complained the cotton shirt was too hot. Bill Rigger found the current shirt which is a "breathable" shirt he also found the supplier (Graham the Hatman).

Clubs Future: I am certain that our TLC caravan club will continue to function whilst ever caravans are on the road. Our membership will always continue to fluctuate however if you look back over the past nine years you can see that we have never closed our books and the membership has fluctuated between 115 and 139 caravans. I consider it reasonable to suggest that the same pattern of

membership will continue into the near future.

Awning Hold Down Clips: Every caravan awning should be secured when extended. Early in the clubs first days Roy Curnow and Clarrie Stevens started experimenting with hold down clips. Clarrie then produced the first model made from mild steel. Members loved them and he gave away the first (10) pair just said "buy me a beer sometime" (he is still waiting for the beers). The next model were mild steel painted, then stainless steel and now they are powder coated. Since those early days Clarrie has posted out over 4500 sets Australia wide.


