They can be any colour or combination of colours, either wool or acrylic. Using 8ply yarn and appropriate needles cast on 3 sts.K1 increase next st, knit to end. Continue this way till you have 50 sts. Knit 1 row. Begin decrease by K1 k2tog knit to end. Continue till 4 sts remain. K1 k2tog K1 Cast off 3 sts. Size is approximately 6"x6". Rug size to suit you, 6x6 squares or 7x4 squares.
