A Very Unusual Recipe Seafood Cocktail Sauce

This recipe has full cream VANILLA ICE CREAM as a basis.

150g Ice Cream (full fat is best) which is just starting to soften.

- 2 1/2 tablespoons tomato sauce
- 1 1/2 tablespoons Worcestershire sauce
- ½ tablespoon lemon juice
- $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon cayenne pepper (cayenne is very variable in strength, taste test required before adding any extra.)

Pinch of salt.

Mix in a small bowl or jug, can use an electric stick mixer though not essential.

Mix close to time to use, make sure you keep it cold.

CP), museum, silo art.


* Quilpie did the small information centre and museum, rail and mini aircraft museum.

Baldy Top Lookout and river walk.


* Eromanga has the most amazing
