Wayne Rush – Tips on Fires and Requirements.

- All caravans legally need a working smoke detector and if you have an annex attached where people are sleeping this also needs one.
- Extinguishers and blankets are for small fires only. Don't be tempted to tackle a larger fire. Vans, cars and homes can be replaced.
- Extinguishers should be replaced every 5 to 10 years. Older smoke detectors only have a life of 10 years and need replacing. (Will continue to beep twice even when batteries are replaced)


