Hartwood Fee's: The committee have determined that each van that attends Hartwood in the future will be asked to contribute an amount of \$3-\$5. We had plenty of time to sight see along the way. All vehicles were clean and fully equipped. We spent 9 days all up driving 2,700 km. The total cost of hire was \$37 plus fuel. All stops at night were in free camp areas except when we had the car, then a motel. We didn't go over the same route twice during the holiday Fuel is approx \$2ltr in NZ. Cost helped by receiving \$1.25 NZ for every Aust \$. I organised everything on the internet before we left home. On completion of the 16 days we joined the cruise ship 'Celebrity Century' in Auckland for a discount 12 day cruise around both islands of NZ and then back via Melbourne arriving in Sydney on Christmas Eve. 


